OCRA course's principles and instructions:

- 1. Prior study of 9 chapters of the OCRA Book
- 2.16 hours of classes and test given at the end
- 3. Evaluation of the course by the participants
- 4. Practical test according to EPM standard
- 5. Evaluation by the teachers of the test results
- 6.Delivery of the certificates to approved participants (97%) + Brazilian OCRA School home page

Results

The interest of each participant was directed to his own professional activity:

- Professionals of the technical areas: practical application in the companies or consultancies
- Government area: to know the methodology for using in supervisions and Law suits
- Judicial experts, lawyers: to get knowledge
- Union members: to get knowledge to use in agreements
- Other professionals: to get knowledge.

- Independently of the different professional areas of the participants, the understanding and learning of the OCRA Method was very similar
